

# CHAPTER 2

## User Interface

### Command Line User Interface

*BERT77* development tools can be used in command line mode, without the Graphical User Interface. From the command line, *BERT77* has the following syntax:

```
bert projectname [options]
```

The *projectname* must either be a FORTRAN program *filename.f* or a list of FORTRAN modules in a project file. If a project file is used then the *projectname* must be preceded by `&`. For instance:

```
bert \&integr.prj
```

will look for a file called `integr.prj`. This file must have a list of FORTRAN modules one per line. For example `integr.prj` might look like:

```
integr.f
integral.f
support.f
```
